

MaksuPay Wix Plugin Installation Guide

Prerequisites:

- A Wix ecommerce store must be set up before beginning the integration process. The store needs payment success, fail and cancel pages with the slug names payment-success, payment-canceled and payment-failed.
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Step-by-Step Installation Process

1. Enable Developer Mode

- From your **Wix Dashboard**, open the **Site Editor**.
- In the editor, **enable Developer Mode** by toggling it on. This will unlock the **Velo by Wix** development tools.

2. Access the Backend & Public Section

- In the left-side navigation menu, go to **Dev Mode** and select **Backend & Public**.

3. Install Required npm Packages

- In the **Packages and Apps** section, install the following npm packages:
 - `node-forge`
 - `jsdom`
- These packages will be necessary for secure data processing and DOM manipulation.

4. Create Payment Service

- Under **Service Providers**, create a new **Payment Service** and name it `maksu-pay`.

5. Add JavaScript Files

- In the **Backend** section, follow these steps:
 - **Create a new Web Module** named `maksu` and paste the contents of the provided `maksu.web.js` file into it.
 - **Add a new JavaScript file** and name it `http-functions.js`. Paste the contents of the provided `http-functions.js` file into this new file.
 - **Create another JavaScript file** named `maksu-pay.js` and paste the contents of the `maksu-pay.js` file.
 - **Create another file** named `maksu-pay-config.js` and paste the contents of the `maksu-pay-config.js` file.

6. Create Payment Success and Payment Cancel Pages

- In the **Wix Editor**, create three new pages:
 - **Payment Success Page:**
 - Name the page `payment-success` and add the content you want users to see upon successful payment (e.g., thank you message, order details).
 - **Payment Cancel Page:**
 - Name the page `payment-cancel` and add a message indicating the payment was not successful (e.g., error message, retry option).

Payment Failed Page:

Name the page `payment-failed` and add a message indicating the payment was not successful (e.g., error message, retry option).

- These pages will be used by the payment service to redirect users based on the payment result.

7. Publish Your Site

- Once all the files are added and configurations are set, **publish your site** to make the changes live.

8. Configure MaksuPay Payment Gateway

- Go to **Dashboard -> Settings -> Accept Payments**.
- You'll see the **MaksuPay connect page**. Select the MaksuPay option and enter the following details:
 - **Merchant ID**
 - **Domain Name**
 - **Payment Service URL**
 - **Refund Service URL**
- Save the configuration.

9. Set Up Secrets in Secrets Manager

- Navigate to **Dashboard -> Developer Tools -> Secrets Manager**.
- Create new secrets for the following values:
 - `maksu-merchant-pri-key`
 - `maksu-merchant-cert`
 - `maksu-signer-certs`
- Enter the corresponding values for each secret as provided.

Final Notes:

- After completing these steps, test the payment system thoroughly to ensure it works as expected.
- Ensure all credentials and URLs are correct to prevent errors during the payment process.
